### NOTES

1. Please notify WORLDwrite if you change your name or address while this Declaration is still in force.
2. You can cancel the Declaration at any time by notifying WORLDwrite
3. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of Cancellation or such later date as you specify.
4. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (Currently 28p for every £1 you give)
5. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (See note 2)
6. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief for yourself on your self-assessment tax return.
7. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief ask the charity. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IRI 13.
